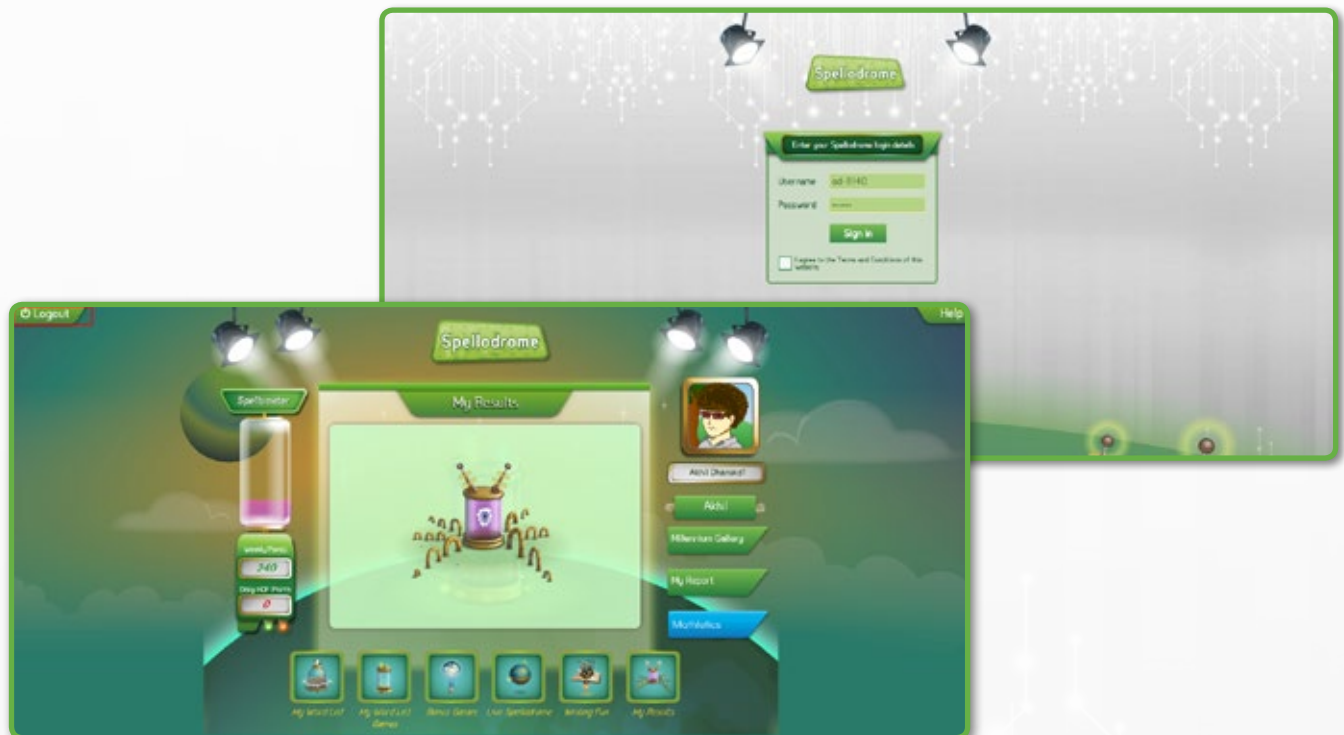

- Click on one of the lists to see all of the words in the set.



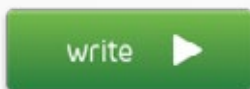
- Click on each word to learn and practice writing the word.

Word Detective

Objective

An exciting word game that is a version of the classic Hangman, the objective of the game is to solve the puzzle of the hidden word.



Instructions

- If you guess the correct letter, you can continue guessing the next letter. However, if the letter guessed is incorrect, then the turn is passed on to your opponent.
- The game is time bound. Pink and blue colors indicates your time. If you do not select a letter before the time lapse, the turn is passed on to your opponent.
- Pink indicates your time line.
- Blue indicates the time line of your computer/opponent.
- Each time you select a letter, the letter gets greyed out. This ensures that you do not to select the same letter a second time.
- The bulb turns green when a selected letter is correct. However, the box turns red when an incorrect letter is selected.
- The winner of the game is the player who selects the final letter that completes a word.
- The player who wins the game gets 50 points.

Word in Pieces

Objective

Match word puzzle pieces to form words. A list of 16 words need to be matched.



Instructions

- Click **OPEN** to view the list of words. Viewing the list of words is optional.



- To match the puzzle pieces, you should locate two pieces of a single word on the screen, and then drag one piece across to the other.
- Each time a word is identified, the selected word is greyed out in the list.
- The progress of the game can be viewed on the left-side corner of the page.
- You can click the close icon to close the word list.
- On identifying all the words, you win 50 points.
- You can exit the game at any point of time by clicking the **Exit** button.

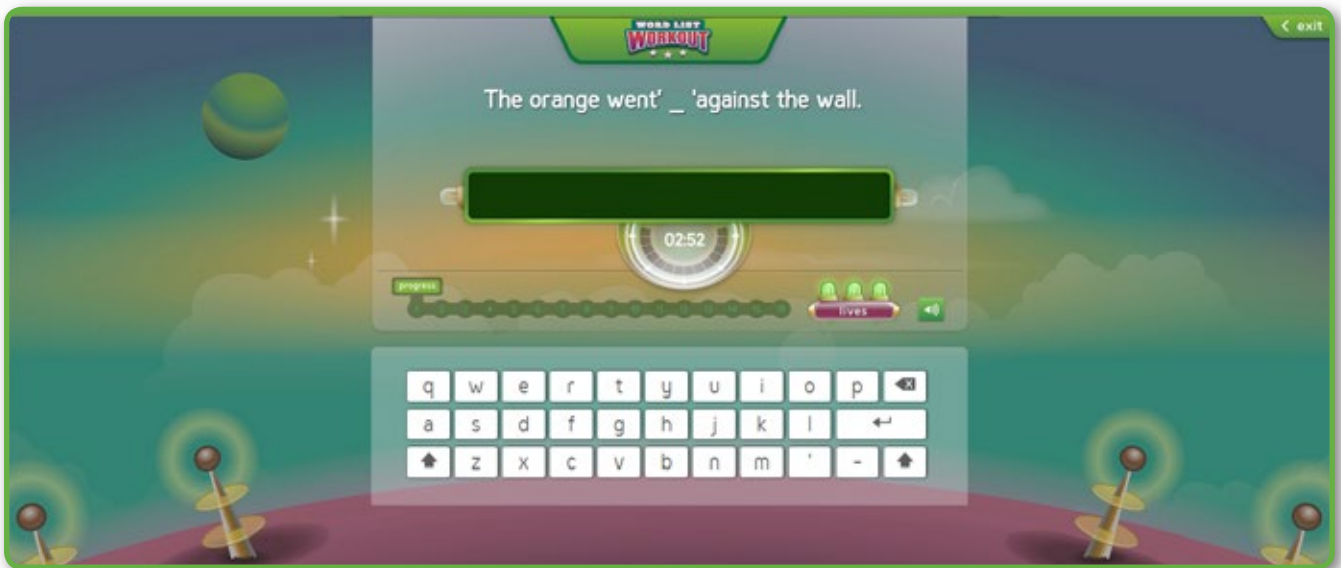

Word List Workout

Objective

Listen to the audio and type the correct word for 16 sentences. You will achieve 10 points for each correct sentence.



Instructions

- You can either type the word manually on your keyboard or select the letters from the virtual keyboard.
- You will get a time limit of three minutes for each sentence. This time frame allows you to listen and type the word.
- The audio will first read the word, and then an example of the word in a sentence.
- When you type a word correctly, you will see a green tick mark. ✓
- When you type an incorrect word, you will see a red cross mark, ✗ followed by the correct spelling of the word.
- Click the speaker icon to listen to the audio again. 
- You have three lives to complete the 16 sentences, which is displayed at the bottom of the screen. If all three lives are consumed, the game ends automatically.
- The progress bar at the bottom of the screen indicates the progress of the game, indicating the number of sentences that you have completed.
- You can exit the game at any point of time by clicking the exit button on the top right-side of the page.


Find a Word

Objective

A traditional game, where the objective is to find 16 hidden words hidden in the grid from the Word List.



Instructions

- Words appear in forward, backward, upward, downward, and diagonal directions.
- As and when you find words in the grid, the words get greyed out in the Word List.
- You can both drag and select words in the grid or you can click each letter manually using your keyboard and select words.
- You can exit the game at any point of time by clicking the **Exit** button  on the top right-side of the page.

Crossword

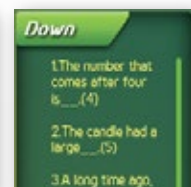
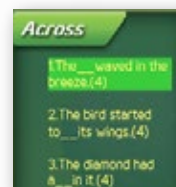
Objective

A traditional crossword game with clues and audio to solve an exciting puzzle.



Instructions

- Click on the clue to hear the word and sentence. The audio will first read the word, and then the sentence.
- You can either type the word manually on your keyboard or select the letters from the virtual keyboard.
- Click **Reset** to restart the game. 
- Click **Erase Mistakes** to check your answers. 
- Click **Submit** to complete the game.

Live Spellodrome

Objective

A simple but interesting game, where you need to listen to the audio and type the correct word, for 10 sentences.

The game has three levels - Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3. These levels are sorted in ascending order of difficulty and can be selected as per your requirement. In Level 1, you will earn 10 points per word and a total of 100 points. In Level 2, you will earn 15 points per word and a total of 150 points. In Level 3, you will earn 20 points per word and a total of 200 points.

In addition to earning these points, you will also have the challenge of beating your best time and winning some amazing shopping credits to customize your profile better!



Instructions

- On the Live Spellodrome home page, you can select **Level 1**, **Level 2**, or **Level 3**, depending on the difficulty level that you want to play, select **World** or **Single Player**, and then click **GO**.
- If you select **Single Player** and click **GO**, the game will begin immediately.

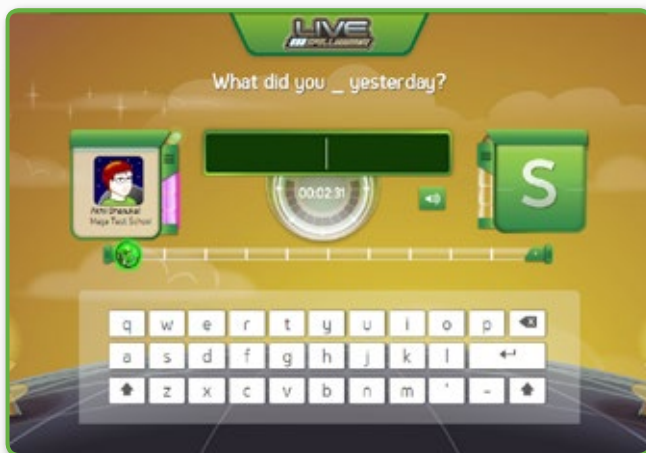

Instructions (cont.)

- However, if you select **World** and click **GO**, the game will first search for the country of the second player. If the game is unable to find a second player, the game will begin with the computer.
- If you simply click **GO** without selecting the level, world, or single player, the game will begin with a default **Level 1** and against **World**.

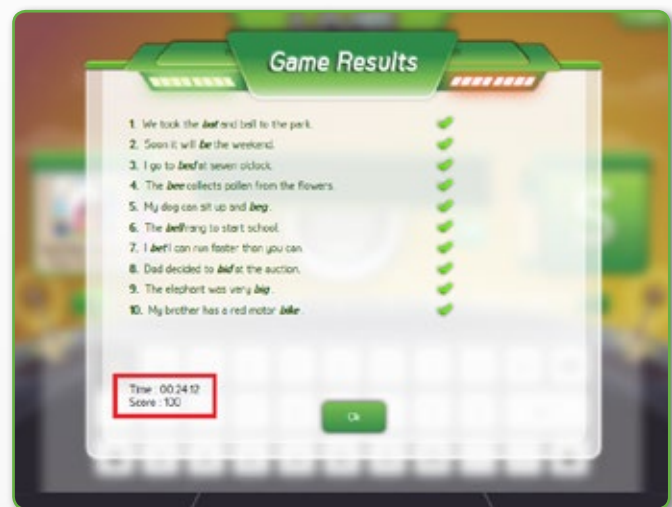

Instructions (cont.)

- You will get a time limit of three minutes to answer ten questions correctly. This time frame allows you to listen and type the word. The audio will first read the word, followed by the example the word.
- You can either type the word manually or select the letters from the virtual keyboard, and then press **Enter**.
- The progress bar indicates the progress of the game and only proceeds on answering a question correctly.
- You only have three lives in case of an incorrect answer. If you consume all three lives, the game ends automatically.
- If you complete answering ten sentences correctly, a **CONGRATULATIONS** pop-up appears.
 - If you play as a single player, you can only win 10 shopping credits for beating your best time.
 - If you play against an opponent, you can win:
 - 5 shopping credits, if you win a game without losing any of your lives.
 - 10 shopping credits, if you beat your best time.
 - 15 shopping credits, if you win a game without losing any of your lives, and beat your best time.
- On clicking **Close** on the **Congratulations** pop-up, the **Game Results** pop-up appears, which provides a summary of your performance, along with the time and score. This includes a list of the sentences that you attempted, which includes correct and incorrect answers.

Instructions (cont.)

- On clicking **exit**, you will go back to the home page of Live Spellodrome.
- On the Spellodrome home page, you can click **My Results** to get a consolidated view of your results on all the levels that you have played in Live Spellodrome.

Text Types

- Information Report** - provides information
- states the facts
- Procedure** - tells how to make or do something, e.g. recipe
- Recount** - retells past events in the order they occurred
- Explanation** - explains how or why something happens
- Persuasion (exposition)** - presents one point of view with reasons
- often used to influence or sell, e.g. advertisement
- Discussion** - presents both sides of an issue, e.g. debate
- Narrative** - tells a story, e.g. folk tale
- Response** - describes personal reactions, e.g. review
- Description** - describes someone or something in detail
- often used in other text types
- Poetry** - words arranged in lines, rhythmic, e.g. verse

Everyday Texts

A text may be FACTUAL (true) or LITERARY (imagined)

Instructions

- There are ten types of texts that you can learn and practice. Click on the radio button to begin learning the desired text type.
- There are six examples to describe each text type. Click on each example to understand each text type better.
- TIPS on the right-hand side of the page explain the examples more elaborately.
- In addition to learning and practicing text types, you can also learn how to write a letter, invitation, email, and news. Click on the respective button to begin practising.
- Click **Downloads and Printables** or **Print** to take a printout of the content that you want to read at a later time.
- Click **Back** to go back to the Spellodrome home page.
