Description

This activity deals with grouping objects in twos. Students are required to state the number of groups and then the total number of objects. They can obtain this answer by counting or by multiplication. *This activity is non adaptive.*

Teaching Hints

Use the visualisation to show that multiplication is a quick way of obtaining the total number of objects. Use counters to emulate the visualisation and discuss the merits of arranging the objects in organised rows and columns.
