

# Dividing Twos

Let's see the maths.

14 shared between 2 = 7 each.  
 $14 \div 2 = 7$

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## Description

In this activity, students divide a group of objects into "fair shares", by working out how many circles can go into each bag evenly. *This activity is non adaptive.*

## Teaching Hints

Use the visualisation to discuss with students what constitutes a "fair share". Reinforce the abstract representation of the picture by referring to the way the number sentence is written.
